We, JSP, certify that the following black, grey and white expanded polypropylene ARPRO® grades comply with the European legislation described here below, relating to plastic materials and articles intended to come into contact with foodstuffs, as follows:

Some authorized components of our black, grey and white expanded polypropylene ARPRO® grades are affected by a SML(T) (specific migration limit), which must not be overcome. As the manufacturing process can affect migration, migration tests have to be performed on final articles by the final manufacturer, so that he can guarantee to the food packager that the limit is not exceeded. The identity of these components can be disclosed only upon request to an accredited laboratory in the frame of a confidentiality agreement.
